### **ABSTRACT**

City bonds, or municipal bonds, are debt securities issues by governmental entities to fund obligations and projects. These are typically issued for such needs as sewer, street improvement, or water projects, but may be issued for many other projects as well. In the Charlotte City Bonds Collection, terms are stipulated on the certificate, and are signed by both the Mayor and City Clerk.
