ABSTRACT

The Charlotte Center was one of fourteen evening college centers in North Carolina dedicated to serving returning veterans. Opening on September 23, 1946, classes met in Central High School. Although closed by the state three years later, Charlotte educational leaders and businessmen collaborated to have the city school district open a junior college. This was done, and Charlotte College opened in 1949. In 1957, the college acquired new property along Highway 49, and officially moved in 1961. Two years later, the North Carolina General Assembly approved Charlotte College as a four-year, state-supported college. On July 1, 1965, Charlotte College became the University of North Carolina at Charlotte.
