ABSTRACT

This collection contains information on two exhibits at the Levine Museum. The brochures from 2005 include descriptions of the *Purses, Platforms, & Power* exhibit about Charlotte women during the 1970s, which opened on March 9, 2005.

The 2006 brochure concerns the exhibit *A Woman's Place, exploring the evolving role of women in the New South and honoring women's leadership in service to the Charlotte-Mecklenburg community*. Also featured is a keynote address titled "Political Tales and Personal Triumphs," lessons for life from veteran journalist Judy Woodruff and includes the presentation of the 2005 Charlotte Woman of the Year Award, in its 50th year.
